

KState at Salina Parking Committee Meeting Minutes  
March 8, 2005

Present: Ezra Olson, Tricia Wilcox, Darwin Abbott, Mike Wise, Bob Homolka, Charlie Beckom, and Chris Laws

Absent: Kenny Windholz, Scott Linenberger, Joel Matthews

Chair Bob Homolka called the meeting to order. He requested to go out of the Agenda's order due to the lack of a quorum at that time.

Old Business:

Ezra and Tricia presented the Recommendation to the Committee for the Modifying of the Aero Parking Lot for Better and Increased Utilization of Motorcycle Parking. Ezra had drawn out the current layout and a proposed layout. Several pictures of bikes in the stalls were included. Discussion was held on whether it would be feasible to move the motorcycle stalls to the north which is currently grass. This would mean breaking out the curb and replacing the grass with concrete. Darwin did not know if Jack Carlson would have to come out and actually see the site or if a determination could be done with the information they have in hand. Charlie thought Facilities could do the work. Compaction of the ground is a concern since the soil conditions allow concrete movement that could shatter what was poured. Darwin did not think any additional lighting would be required. Ezra asked about the barrier over by Building 820. Question was asked if it would be better to move the motorcycle lot over to that small lot. Charlie said the drainage in that area is poor and we are currently leasing the building from Airport Authority. Bob asked Mike to visit with Marlon Johnston about the Committee's Recommendation since concerns were raised about losing vehicle stalls in the lot with the proposed layout. Bob asked for a motion to submit the BET (Brendan, Ezra, Tricia) document to the University Engineers. It was moved and seconded. Vote was taken and motion carried. Darwin will take the Recommendation to the University Engineers. Bob thanked Ezra and Tricia for the work they had done.

November minutes were approved after the correcting the spelling of Ezra's last name. February minutes were approved. Bob stated this was Kenny's last year on the Committee. Marlene Walker handles the filling of that position through Classified Senate. Mike said after the last snow storm the Aero East parking area had been cleaned by the time he came in to work.

Parking Open Forum will be Thursday, April 14 in the College Center Conference Room from 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. Pat will have flyers made and contact Jaci Walsh to put in the campus newsletter.

New Business:

Tricia had been approached about residence hall student workers who work for Facilities getting ticketed for parking down there. Charlie explained those students are the only ones guaranteed a parking spot on campus. Their lots are restricted to only those permits.

Chris reported that the Fee Subcommittee would not be asking for an increase this year.

Mike asked how the students were appointed to the Committee. Ezra and Chris said as Senators, they are appointed to be part of committees.
